

Oak Ridge gets back on track at Conroe

The Oak War Eagles snapped a three-game losing streak and got back to their winning ways against Conroe Friday night with a 49-35 win at Buddy Moorhead Stadium.

Senior quarterback Steve Smedley had a huge night with six touchdown passes and was 16-for-22 for 368 yards.

Conroe (3-3, 2-2), which has dropped two straight, led 28-21 at halftime before the War Eagles (2-3, 1-2) outscored it 28-7 in the second half.

Five different War Eagles caught touchdown passes with Camden Morgan totaling two. He had 84 yards.

Frankie Arthur caught one touchdown pass, rushed for another and had 286 yards (195 rushing) of total offense.

JaQuale Harrison, Elijah Porter and Tevian Jefferson each had one touchdown reception.

Junior linebacker Justin Williams had nine tackles and a sack. Joseph Jonah-Ajoyne also caught a touchdown pass.

Dramekco Green had a 69-yard touchdown run and caught touchdown passes of 80 and 20 yards from quarterback Javarious Hatchett.

Hatchett also had a 1-yard touchdown run. Nigel Leday had a 4-yard touchdown run for the Tigers.

Oak Ridge has won nine of ten against Conroe with the loss coming last year.

The War Eagles host Grand Oaks this Friday while Conroe makes a trip to co-district leader New Caney, which is 5-0 (3-0) on the season.
