Oak Ridge blanks Caney Creek

The Oak Ridge War Eagles secured their second shutout in District 13-6A in the process with a 49-0 win at Caney Creek Friday night.

The War Eagles (6-3, 5-2) have won five straight games and allowed just 14 points in the past four. Oak Ridge hadn't shutout an opponent since 2009, before blanking Cleveland on Oct. 14.

Frankie Arthur continues to put up a strong season as he scored three more touchdowns against the Panthers and now has 15 on the season. He totaled a teamhigh 141 yards on 10 touches. Justin Hayes rushed for 134 yards on 19 carries and a score.

War Eagles senior quarterback Steve Smedley threw for 105 yards and three touchdowns. Elijah Porter caught two of those touchdown strikes and Camden Morgan had one.

Joseph Wilson led in tackles with nine while Jaentrie Fleeks had eight. Jaylen Jackson scored on a fumble recovery.

For Caney Creek (1-8, 0-7), which has dropped eight straight, Jaiden Graves piled up 139 yards on 20 touches. Joel Perz had seven tackles.

Oak Ridge takes on Willis this Friday at Woodforest Bank Stadium.

Caney Creek ends the season at New Caney the same night.
